MUSIC

While guests arrive, play lively tunes from Ethiopia's Golden Age of Music, like Alemayehu Eshete.

Once everyone is settled in, move on to the 'father of Ethio-jazz', Mulatu Astatke, to accompany the meal.

As the evening progresses, wind down with Amharic love songs or gentle masengo strings for a warm ambience.

ACTIVITIES

Greet guests with informal Ethiopian phrases, e.g. "selam!" (hello) and "ameseginalehu!" (thank you).

Share the cultural significance of the meal as a way of marking key celebrations.

Perform a mini buna ceremony, an Ethiopian coffee ritual, as post-meal entertainment.

Discuss the impact of supporting SHE on aspiring women entrepreneurs and their communities.

DECORATIONS

- Green, yellow, red and blue (colours found in flag)
- Traditional patterns found on embroidered netela

Table decorations

- Runners and napkins in colour palette
- Woven placemats
- Candles in a mound of coffee beans as a centrepiece
- Map outline as menu cards/QR codes for JustGiving page

Extra elements

- Photo wall with flag bunting and SHE branding
- Take-home goodie bags containing menu cards, thank-you notes, SHE information leaflets, etc.
