## MUSIC

While guests arrive, play lively sungura tunes from icons Alick Macheso and Leonard Zhakata.

Once everyone is settled in, move on to soulful afro-jazz and chimurenga rhythms (Oliver Mtukudzi, Thomas Mapfumo) to accompany the meal.

As the evening progresses, wind down with soft traditional mbira tracks for a warm ambience.

## DECORATIONS

### Colour palette

- Green, yellow, red, black and white (colours found in flag)
- Bold, colourful Shona/Ndebele prints

### Table decorations

- Runners and napkins in colour palette
- Woven placemats
- In-shell peanuts and fairy lights in jars as a centrepiece
- Map outline as menu cards/QR codes for JustGiving page

### Extra elements

- Photo wall with flag bunting and SHE branding
- Take-home goodie bags containing menu cards, thank-you notes, SHE information leaflets, etc.

## ACTIVITIES

Greet guests with informal Zimbabwean phrases, e.g. “*mhororo!*” (hello) and “*tatenda!*” (thank you).

Roll sadza with guests, demonstrating how to scoop nyama with your hands.

Share the cultural significance of the meal as a national staple enjoyed between loved ones.

Discuss the impact of supporting SHE on aspiring women entrepreneurs and their communities.
